Notice of Disposal and Invitation for Expressions of Interest: Electric Tramcar Halle an der Saale (HAVAG) Tramways No. 902





As the result of a collections review, the National Tramway Museum (Tramway Museum Society) is seeking to dispose of **Halle an der Saale (HAVAG) tramcar No. 902 -** a single deck; allenclosed bogie electric tramcar, built in 1969.

Timeline of Halle 902:

- 1969 2005: Operational on original tramway (Halle, Germany)
- 2005 2007: Imported to the UK and operational at Crich Tramway Village.
- 2007 May 2018: Withdrawn from operation and on static display at Crich.
- May 2018 2022: Stored at Rigby Road depot, Blackpool.
- 2022 present: Returned to Crich and placed in off-site storage nearby.

Our aim is for Halle 902 to remain in the public sector if possible, and we are inviting expressions of interest from organisations who would be interested in acquiring this vehicle. Museums, heritage organisations and transport organisations intending to offer public access to the vehicle will be prioritised in the first instance, but all expressions of interest for any use will be considered. Halle 902 is being offered free of charge. However, all removal and transport costs will be the responsibility of the acquiring organisation.
